

## 2023 Annual Fire Expo (AFX) Frequently Asked Questions

Question	Answer
<b>Q:</b> I'm a current member of AFAA, but I'm not seeing member pricing for the expo. What should I do?	<b>A:</b> Ensure that you are logged into your member profile. Once you have verified that, check to see if you are selecting 'Register Yourself' or 'Registering Guest' on the registration form. Register Guest will not show member pricing.
<b>Q:</b> I'm a current member of AFAA, I'm registering myself and a co-worker, but I'm not seeing member pricing for them. Why is that?	<b>A:</b> Member benefits do not rollover to others within your company. Both individuals must be current members with AFAA to receive the discounted rate.
<b>Q:</b> I only want to register as a vendor for the expo, can I do that?	<b>A:</b> Yes, you can! Use the same registration form and follow the prompts. Please contact us with any questions or issues.
<b>Q:</b> I only want to register as a sponsor for the expo, can I do that?	<b>A:</b> Yes, you can! Follow the prompts accordingly on the registration form.
<b>Q:</b> Am I able to bring a guest with me to the vendor reception and other activities?	<b>A:</b> Yes, you can! We are requesting a small fee of \$100 for guests and \$50 for kid(s).
<b>Q:</b> If I selected 'no' on bringing a guest when I registered, but have since changed my mind; can I still bring them?	<b>A:</b> Yes, you can! Please e-mail <a href="mailto:alex@afaa.org">alex@afaa.org</a> to get this taken care of.
<b>Q:</b> Will transportation be provided to and from the hotel and airport?	<b>A:</b> No, we will not be offering this. Transportation is on your own.
<b>Q:</b> What is the room rate at the hotel?	<b>A:</b> \$194/night
<b>Q:</b> I don't see the hotel booking link on the website. Can you tell me where it is?	<b>A:</b> A link to book your hotel room will be provided upon registering.
<b>Q:</b> What is the dress code for the President's Dinner?	<b>A:</b> Casual – wear what you are comfortable in!
